EVENT DETAILS

- Your registration will not be considered complete/accepted until payment is received.
- Cancellation notice REQUIRED no later than September 1, 2026, in order to receive a refund.
 - PLEASE LET US KNOW IN ADVANCE IF YOU CAN NO LONGER MAKE THE EVENT.
- Vendor set up is from 7:30am – 10:00am on Monday, September 7. Please arrive early to unload for set up and remove your vehicle to an outside parking area when finished unloading. No large vehicles will be allowed to stay as part of your vending area unless approved by event staff.
- For pedestrian safety, vehicles are not allowed into the park to unload after 9:30am.
- Setting up the night before is not allowed.
- Your vendor location will be assigned to you prior to the start of the event.
- One lunch voucher is included with each purchased vendor space.

We hope that you will consider participating in our Septemberfest events, it can be a wonderful fundraising event for your non-profit organization and a great opportunity to expose your business or products. VENDOR RULES & GUIDELINES

1. If your space will be larger than a single 12' x 12', please register and pay for the number of spaces that will cover your needs.
2. Vendors must bring their own tables, chairs, signs, and price sheets.
3. Pricing should be visible or accessible to shoppers.
4. If you have special needs regarding space, access to electricity or location, it must be noted with your application. This is on a first received, first served basis.
5. Vendors are required to either pay their own sales taxes or fill out the envelope provided by the WRB Rec & Park District, and we will submit sales tax for you. Please make checks payable to WRB Rec & Park District.
6. After unloading, all vehicles must be moved outside of the park. There will be a designated parking lot for all vendors.
7. **Vehicles entering the park before 4:00pm**, to load your belongings, is not permitted without Septemberfest committee approval. This is for the safety of all people enjoying the event.
8. Vendor space location and size will be mapped out according to the dimensions and special needs you note on application.
9. Vendors must ensure their space is thoroughly cleaned and picked up after the event.
10. Produce and other food goods must be fresh, clean, and presentable. Containers used for the sale and transportation must be clean and sanitary.
11. WRB Rec and Park District Septemberfest reserves the right to approve or deny vendor applicants. Vendors are required to respect fellow vendors and customers and any vendors that are in violation may be asked to leave for the remainder of the day without a refund.
12. All packaged food products are required to have labels that include Identity Statement, Net Weight Statement, List of Ingredients, Company Name and Address. Please see the website below for more information regarding good labels:

13. We recommend vendors have their own liability insurance. If vendors choose not to provide proof of insurance, then by signing this form they acknowledge WRB Rec and Park Districts Septemberfest is released from all liability, including if someone becomes ill due to the sale of their products or if someone is injured by an unsafe canopy.

Special Event Sales Tax

Western Rio Blanco Recreation and Park District has a Special Event Sales Tax License for the 2026 Septemberfest event. If you do not have a Sales Tax License, we can submit your Sales Tax for you. You will need to submit a provided report with gross sales and tax collected at this event. You will need to turn your taxes in to us by the end of the day on September 7, 2026.

We are required to turn in a list of all vendors present at this event to the State of Colorado Dept. of Revenue. It will tell the State of Colorado who turned in taxes for us to submit and who did not.

Exemptions: Some foods may be exempt from licensing under the Cottage Food Act: Senate Bill 12-048. To see if this applies to you, please refer to: <https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/cottage-foods-act>
